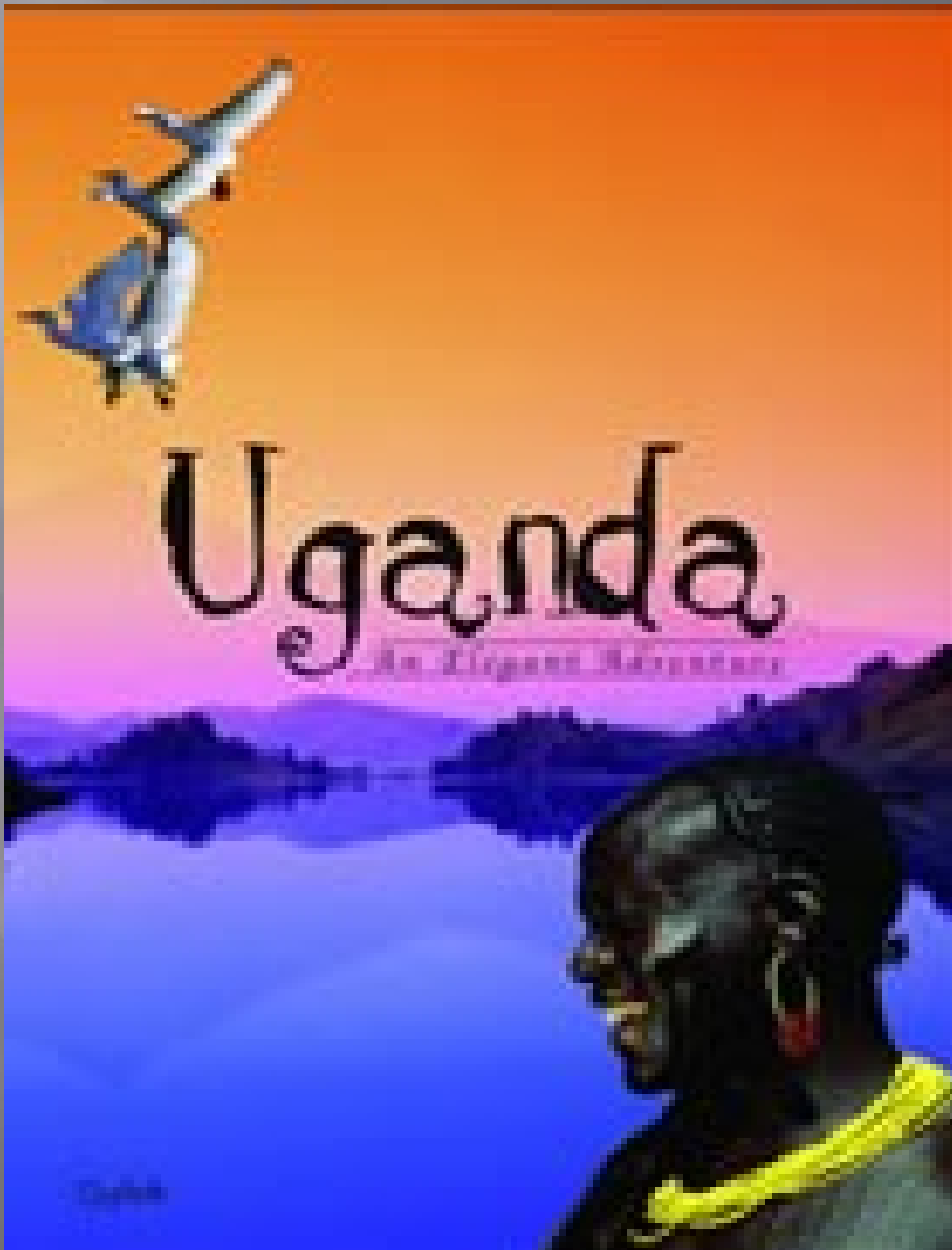


Most of our children have lost parents through Aids and are part of an extended family or being cared by grandparents.
